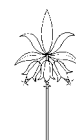

These watercolors by John Wilkinson (England 1934–) are from the original, complete set of illustrations for Wilkinson and Alan Mitchell, *Collins handguide to the trees of Britain and Northern Europe* (London, William Collins Sons & Co. Ltd., 1978), acquired from the artist in 1987 for the Hunt Institute's collection. The paintings include trees that can be seen in the woods, forests, hedges, parks, gardens and town streets of the British Isles and northern Europe. John Wilkinson has held a number of one-man exhibitions in London and has won medals for his paintings from the Royal Horticultural Society. He has also illustrated guides to mushrooms and toadstools, butterflies and moths, cats, and the countryside. Wilkinson's work was included in the Hunt Institute's *5th International Exhibition of Botanical Art & Illustration*, 1983, *Botanical Watercolors by British Artists Andrew Brown and John Wilkinson*, 1995, and *Gifts of Winter*, 2000. His work is included in several private collections including the Dr. Shirley Sherwood collection, London. He occasionally holds residential painting courses in England and continues to paint a wide range of subjects.
